Minor Puppy Dog (5)

- 1st Tanner's Felinoak Griffyn (Ai) BPD & BPIS
 8 month tri puppy dog. Masculine head with pleasing expression and eye, well flewed muzzle. Good reach of neck into well laid shoulders. Chest well let down below the elbow. Good shaped quarters, well bent stifle, tailset and neat feet. Moved well. Preferred the balance of this one.
- 2nd Jones' Clairdale Grantchester
 8 month t/w puppy. Not as mature as 1. Head still needs to come. Nice reach of neck into shoulder, good depth of chest. Quarters, tailset good.
- 3rd Jepson & Jones' Eardley Trot On

Puppy Dog (4)

- 1st Ambridge's Julemark Chaos Tri dog that is cooperating better with his owner now he's a little older. Head still to come but he has pleasing pigment. Good neck and shoulder, round bone leading into neat feet. Pleasing body shape, width of chest and stifle.
- 2nd Coates' Gladstyle Born Ready Still very much a baby but good shape overall with correct tailset. Needs to settle more on the move but that will come with time.
- 3rd Jepson & Jones' Eardley Party Boy

Junior Dog (5)

- 1st Fellows' Rosanka Bridges Well developed t/w dog with pleasing head. Nice reach of neck into well placed shoulder. Round bone into neat feet. Good length and size, well bent stifle. Correct tailset and well shaped rear. Moved well.
- 2nd Havard's Annavah Justify Brightly marked tri dog with masculine head, square flews and pleasing eye. Good reach of neck into shoulder, well bent stifle, good quarters and tailset.
- 3rd Binks' Tannahill Ezra

Yearling Dog (1, 1 Abs)

1st Pockington-Hall's Bayard Bee Good Stood alone. Balanced t/w dog. Well shaped head but heavier than I would like. Good neck, shoulder with solid bone, tailset, moved well.

Novice Dog (3, 1 Abs)

- 1st Firth's Palmerwill Whisky By Nictoney
 Was beaten for higher placings in MP and P by more mature puppies. Pleasing outline, good neck and shoulder allowing forward movement. Mild expression, good head properties, dark eye and pigment. Good bone into neat feet, chest yet to drop but neat elbows and good tailset. Very immature at the moment. Needs to settle on the move.
- 2nd Timmins' Timollymae Ace
 3yr old tri dog. Not the shoulder placement of 1 and therefore stuffy in neck. I felt he was balanced however with a good width of chest. Happy demeanour.

Graduate Dog (2, 1 Abs)

1st Philpott's Charterwood Herald Smart blanket tri with good shape head and flews. Pleasing body shape with good width of chest, nicely shaped stifle and hocks, neat manicured feet. Carried himself well.

Post Graduate Dog (1, 1 Abs)

1st Timmins' Timollymae Ace. Placed 2nd Novice Dog.

Mid Limit Dog (5)

- 1st Goldberg's Molesend Giorgio
 Up to size but super make and shape. Masculine but with pleasing gentle expression, nicely rimmed dark eyes, good earset. Good body shape and tailset. Correct shoulder placement and strong quarters allowed him to drive around the ring.
- 2nd Foster's Stormpasture Saddlesoap Very smart t/w dog of good make and shape. Pleasing head proportions but not the expression of 1. Wish he didn't move quite so enthusiastically!
- 3rd Jones' Molesend Colt (Ai)

Limit Dog (6, 1 Abs)

- 1st Jones' Clairdale Fusilier CC & BIS This dog caught my eye on entering the ring. Very balanced tri dog with well shaped head, good flews, pleasing expression with dark eye and pigment. Good width of chest, round bone leading into neat feet. Nice reach of neck into well laid shoulders, pleasing body shape and rear, correct tailset with stern that he carried on the move. Moved parallel. Delighted to award CC and BOB.
- 2nd Parker & Stevens' Serenaker Salty Dog Pleasing in head and expression, liked his body shape, chest well let down, moved well but didn't find him as balanced as 1.

Open Dog (2)

1st Parker & Stevens' Ch Serenaker Armani RCC Tri dog of pleasing proportions, mild expression, good eye shape, pigment and rims. Pleasing reach of neck leading into well laid shoulders, good depth of chest, bend of stifle and well shaped quarters, round bone leading into neat feet. Moved well both ways.

2nd Philpott's Charterwood Chancellor Smart tri dog with masculine head, pleasing eye and pigment. Good body shape and quarters.

Veteran Dog (4, 1 Abs)

- 1st Dawson & Goodall's Ch Janfrey Randal Upon Rundle Jw Sh.cm Vw BVD Well balanced tri dog of 11 years. Good head properties and shape with well let down chest and shapely quarters. Drove enthusiastically around the ring.
- 2nd Hunt's Ch Shercroft Apollo Jw Sh.cm
 Slightly heavier mould. Stronger in head than I would like but is a well made hound.
 Pleasing eye. Good round bone leading into neat feet. Of good overall shape.
 Moved true both ways.
- **3rd** Jones' Newlin Preston to Clairdale Jw

Minor Puppy Bitch (7, 1 Abs)

- 1st Jones' Clairdale Galatea BPB
 T/W very feminine, lovely eye and expression, good headshape and pigment. Well bodied for age, good reach neck and shapely quarters. Moved well.
- 2nd Goldberg's Molesend Hazelnut Just 6 months so needs to learn to settle. Lovely make and shape, head still needs to come but pleasing shape and expression. Good round bone, neck into shoulder and well shaped quarters.
- 3rd Havard's Annavah Chantilly Cream

Puppy Bitch (5)

- 1st Foster's Stormpasture Surprise Very smart pocket rocket!! Please slow her down. Good proportions and head shape but would like a softer eye. Good neck into shoulder, legs and feet. Well bodied.
- 2nd Firth's Nictoney Athena Very raw blanket tri. Love her neck and shoulder, good proportions all round. Will trouble the best in time. Needs to learn to move as she was erratic and this let her down.
- 3rd Griffin's Clarismore Winter Luxury

Junior Bitch (5, 1 Abs)

Lovely class overall. These could change places on another occasion.

- 1st Banks' Forgebanks Shantung Jw Tri bitch that moved well both ways. Attractive head with feminine expression, dark pigment and eye. Round bone leading into neat feet. Good reach of neck into shoulder, well shaped body, stifle and correct tail carriage.
- 2nd Havard's Annavah Teardrop
 Another attractive bitch of good proportions, nicely pigmented eye rims and dark eyes. Soft expression. Good bone into tight feet, well bent stifles and rear.
- 3rd Hardisty's Blunderhall Saucy Sally

Yearling Bitch (3, 1 abs)

- 1st Jepson & Jones' Eardley Smartypants Neat tri bitch, pleasing head, gentle expression. Nice neck and shoulder, good body shape and tailset. Preferred her rear movement over 2.
- 2nd Binks' Tannahill Calissa Liked this bitch's make and shape, pigment and tailset. Wasn't fully co-operating with her handler which affected her rear movement.

Novice Bitch (3, 2 Abs)

1st Tofts' Jarrowley Opal
 Nicely made t/w, gentle expression with good head properties. Good straight front, round bone into neat feet, pleasing body shape, topline drops slightly towards tailset. Well shaped quarters, moved nicely.

Graduate Bitch (2, 2 Abs)

Post Graduate Bitch (4, 1 Abs)

- 1st Mead's Stormpasture Strumpette For Rosroden T/W bitch, pretty head, very feminine soft expression with dark expressive eyes, good reach of neck into well laid shoulders, balanced, nicely bodied up. Neat feet. Moved well both ways.
- 2nd Statham's Serenaker Paloma At Brigam
 Was a close decision between these two bitches. Pleasing head and expression.
 Shapely body with good bend of stifle. Preferred the front of 1.
- 3rd Hardisty's Blunderhall Kiss Me Quick

Mid Limit Bitch (6, 2 Abs)

1st Hunt's Dufosee Iyla At Bondlea Jw Pleasing tri bitch that moved well both ways. Well made and of good shape, bone, feet, pleasing head and expression,

- 2nd Lennard's Butterow Token Pleasing shaped bitch. Good head properties, bone, well shaped feet. Tailset is correct but tends to carry gaily at times. Moved well.
- 3rd Dawson & Goodall's Evalux Cashmere Upon Rundle Jw

Limit Bitch (8, 4 Abs)

- 1st Lennard's Butterow Unity Very sound balanced bitch, pleasing head and expression, good reach of neck into well laid shoulders, round bone, good body shape and quarters. Moved very well both ways with good width behind.
- 2nd Arden's Annavah Star Above Madika Aw(S) Eye catching bitch, moves well. Alert feminine expression, good pigment and eye rims, reachy neck into good shoulder, well shaped quarters.
- 3rd Parker & Stevens' Serenaker Manhatten

Open Bitch (6, 1 Abs)

- 1st Deans' Ch Gempeni Cornflower Shcex CC & RBIS Have admired this bitch from ringside and she didn't disappoint. Attractive feminine head and expression, neat parallel front into tight feet, good bone. Reachy neck into well laid shoulders. Good body shape, level topline, nicely shaped quarters, correct tailset with a stern she used both on the move and when stacked.
- 2nd Goldberg's Ch Molesend Dormouse Jw RCC Nicely shaped bitch, smaller mould to 1. Balanced all through, mild expression with expressive eyes. Good bone, well shaped quarters. Moved well.
- 3rd Ch Annavah Princess Tiana

Veteran Bitch (8, 2 Abs)

- 1st Havard's Annavah Knick Knack BVB BVIS Faded tri bitch, dark expressive eyes, very sound mover both ways. Good shape, neck and shoulders, well made quarters.
- 2nd Parker & Stevens' Ch Serenaker Elle's Belles Good outline, square flews, dark eyes, pleasing head and body shape, well bent stifles and quarters. Moved well.
